WHEREAS, The Philippines remains flooded after Typhoon Ketsana devastated the island leaving more than 300 people dead and more than 350,000 people without access to their homes; and,

WHEREAS, The death toll has risen to 129 in Samoa, 32 in American Samoa. with 10 people unaccounted for and at least 704 deaths in Indonesia with 1,000 to 3,000 people still unaccounted for; and,
