WHEREAS, The City is facing a severe housing crisis during which skyrocketing rents and real estate values have been fueling the systematic displacement of working people, families, people of color, senior citizens and others on fixed or limited incomes; and

WHEREAS, St. Mary's Medical Center proposed sale of fourteen residential buildings with over seventy rental units could result in numerous evictions of long-term tenants; and

WHEREAS, The loss of these affordable rental housing units would diminish the City's rental stock and could be disastrous for existing tenants of the buildings; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the St. Mary's Medical Center to take measures to preserve the limited stock of affordable rental housing; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges St. Mary's Medical Center to obtain more community input on its proposed sale of fourteen residential buildings; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges St. Mary's to consider granting its tenants' request for a deed restriction that prohibits the eviction of tenants for purposes of owner move-in, including evictions pursuant to the Ellis Act; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges St. Mary's Medical Center to explore creative financing mechanisms to assist tenants in the purchase of their own units.
