WHEREAS, Allen White has worked under the direction of Community College Board Member Rodel Rodis, Commissioner Dennis Normandy, and Philippine News Publisher Alex Esclamado to coordinate the largest state dinner in the history of San Francisco with over 4,000 persons in attendance to honor Philippine President Corazon Aquino; and,

WHEREAS, Allen White has worked under the direction of Reverend Jim Mitulski, Reverend Penny Nixon, and Reverend Karen Foster, Pastors of Metropolitan Community Church of San Francisco, on numerous projects; and,

WHEREAS, Allen White has coordinated for nearly twenty years multiple aspects of the annual candlelight vigil remembering the assassinations of Supervisors Harvey Milk and Mayor George Moscone and their dedication to coalition building as well as their passion for celebrating the diversity of all people; and,

WHEREAS, Allen White, with the participation of Supervisors Mark Leno, Leslie Katz, Tom Ammiano, Jose Medina, Sue Bierman, Amos Brown, Mayor Willie Brown and Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi produced "A Stand Against Hate," the only organized response by any city to the 1998 Ku Klux Klan killing in Texas; and,

WHEREAS, Allen White, for more than a decade, served as the Media Coordinator for Service Employees International Union, Local 250, providing opportunity for health care workers to be heard on the issues which confound America today; and,

WHEREAS, Allen White, under the tutelage of Janice Mirikitani and Cecil Williams, served as media coordinator to spread the unique message of Glide Memorial Church across our nation; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends Allen White for all his good work and advocacy to forward the principles of diversity, inclusiveness, and equality of all persons; and be it
