URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO OPEN SPACE/PARK RENOVATION CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND THE GENERAL MANAGER OF THE SAN FRANCISCO RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT TO MAINTAIN THE PRIORITY ONE STATUS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF ESPRIT PARK AND THE RECOMMENDED ALLOCATION OF \$1 MILLION FROM THE FY 1999-2000 OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION BUDGET TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF ESPRIT PARK.

WHEREAS, on December 1, 1998, the San Francisco Open Space/Park Renovation Citizens Advisory Committee awarded Priority One Status and recommended a preliminary budget allocation of \$1 million toward the purchase of Esprit Park; and

WHEREAS, Although privately developed and owned, the Park has always been open to the public and has provided priceless park land otherwise unavailable to the diverse communities of Dogpatch, Potrero Hill, and the Third Street corridor for over fifteen years; and

WHEREAS, The available property in surrounding neighborhoods continue to be developed largely as live-work units which do not provide open space for their occupants or the community; and

WHEREAS, The current needs for parks and open space will become even more acute as the eastern portion of San Francisco continues to be developed; and

WHEREAS, The City's purchase of Esprit Park is a unique opportunity to obtain an existing, fully-developed park almost two acres in size and complete with mature trees. strolling paths and open lawns; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Open Space/Park Renovation Citizens Advisory Committee to maintain their Priority One status and preliminary budget allocation of \$1 million toward the purchase of Esprit Park; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the General Manager of the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department to maintain the Priority One status and budget allocation of \$1 million toward the purchase of Esprit Park in his FY 1999-2000 budget proposal to the San Francisco Recreation and Park Commission and San Francisco Planning Commission.
