[Paratransit Debit Card Program]

STIPULATING COMPATIBILITY OF DEBIT CARD PROGRAM WITH CITY'S EFFORTS TO IMPLEMENT A CENTRALIZED DISPATCHING SYSTEM FOR TAXICAB SERVICE.

WHEREAS, The City is implementing a debit card program to serve as a fare collection instrument for the paratransit taxi program; and,

WHEREAS, By Ordinance number 301-98, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors has required that all taxicab companies participate in the paratransit program by the end of 1999, requiring debit card participation as one of the minimum conditions for participation; and,

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Department's Accessible Services is currently specifying and procuring debit card technology to be implemented by paratransit taxicab providers, and is specifying this equipment based upon requirements of the paratransit program and compatibility with taxicab company requirements; and,

WHEREAS, The debit card program will install mobile data terminals in taxicabs and this hardware is a necessary precursor should taxicab companies choose to implement a computerized dispatching system; and,

WHEREAS, Per the recommendation of the Mayor's Taxi Task Force, the City may choose to implement a city-wide centralized dispatching system for general public taxicab service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the debit card procurement program underway by the Public Transportation Department will specify in its procurement documents that debit card equipment purchased will be compatible with a centralized dispatching system to be developed in the future; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the Public Transportation Department utilize its consultant to advise it, the new Taxi Commission, and the taxi companies about appropriate equipment that will be compatible with centralized dispatching; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby ask the Public Transportation Department's Accessible Services division to provide updates to the Board on the progress of this project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby request that a copy of this resolution be sent to Public Transportation Department's Accessible Services, 949
