URGING THE CALIFORNIA AIDS DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO DEVISE A COMPREHENSIVE NOTIFICATION SYSTEM FOR ITS CLIENTS.

WHEREAS, AIDS drug treatments can cost as much as \$12,000 a year; and,

WHEREAS, The AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) pays for the drug treatments for uninsured and underinsured persons with HIV; and,

WHEREAS, ADAP requires clients to certify their eligibility for the program annually; and,

WHEREAS, Many ADAP recipients have not been warned in advance that their eligibility is about to expire and prescriptions are being rejected even for clients possessing ADAP cards which have a subsequent expiration date; and,

WHEREAS, The Health, Family and Environment Committee of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco held a hearing on November 12, 1998 to investigate the premature lapses in eligibility for San Franciscans participating in the AIDS Drug Assistance Program; and,

WHEREAS, Changes in the ADAP client notification process are needed to ensure that clients are aware of pending eligibility expiration dates; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the California AIDS Drug Assistance Program to devise a comprehensive notification system for its clients to inform them of their eligibility expiration; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board forward a copy of this resolution to the California AIDS Drug Assistance Program.
