OF SAN FRANCISCO FINANCE CORPORATION: APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND

DELIVERY OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SITE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE

CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, AS LESSOR, AND THE CITY AND COUNTY

OF SAN FRANCISCO FINANCE CORPORATION, AS LESSEE, RELATING TO CERTAIN

POLICE AND FIRE FACILITIES LOCATED IN THE CITY (AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN

THIS RESOLUTION); APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FIRST

AMENDMENT TO LEASE AND OPTION TO PURCHASE BETWEEN THE CORPORATION.

AS LESSOR, AND THE CITY, AS LESSEE, RELATING TO THE PROPERTY; APPROVING

THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE OF TRUST

AMONG THE CORPORATION, THE CITY AND THE TRUSTEE; APPROVING THE

EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A CONTINUING DISCLOSURE CERTIFICATE RELATING

TO SAID BONDS; RATIFYING PREVIOUS ACTIONS TAKEN IN CONNECTION WITH THE

FOREGOING MATTERS; ADOPTING FINDINGS UNDER THE CALIFORNIA

ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT AND FINDINGS PURSUANT TO CITY PLANNING CODE

SECTION 101.1; AND AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF APPROPRIATE ACTIONS IN

CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, The voters of the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") have approved the lease financing of a citywide emergency radio system (the "Emergency Radio System") and related equipment (collectively, the "Project") through the issuance of lease revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Finance Corporation (the "Corporation"), a California nonprofit benefit corporation, has been formed, among other purposes, to facilitate lease financing for the City; and,

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF FINANCE AND LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the City (the "Board of Supervisors") has set aside and selected a portion of the various facilities under the jurisdiction of the City Health Commission, Fire Commission and Police Commission (as further described in Section 1 below, the "Property") for purposes of leasing under a lease financing transaction to provide funds for the construction and acquisition of the Emergency Radio System; and,

WHEREAS, The City Health Commission, Fire Commission and Police Commission, as appropriate, have heretofore approved the proposed lease financing transaction, including the lease of the portion of the Property under the jurisdiction of each such Commission; and,

WHEREAS, The Corporation and the City have entered into a Site Lease, dated as of January 1, 1998 (the "Site Lease") pursuant to which the City agreed to lease the Property to the Corporation; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to a lease and option to purchase, dated as of January 1, 1998 (the "Lease"), the Corporation agreed to lease the Property to the City; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to an indenture of trust, dated as of January 1, 1998 (the "Indenture"), the Corporation was authorized to issue two or more series of lease revenue bonds in a maximum aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 (the "Bonds") secured primarily by base rentals to be paid by the City under the Lease; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Indenture, the Corporation has heretofore issued the first series of the Bonds (the "Series 1998-I Bonds") in the aggregate principal amount of \$31,250,000; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Indenture, as supplemented by a first supplemental indenture of trust (the "First Supplemental Indenture"), the Corporation desires to issue the second series of the Bonds (the "Series 1999-I Bonds"); and,

WHEREAS, In connection with the Series 1999-I Bonds, the City shall enter into a first amendment to site lease agreement (the "First Amendment to Site Lease") with the

Corporation, whereby the Property, as amended therein, shall be leased to the Corporation; and,

WHEREAS, The Corporation shall lease back the Property, as amended therein, to the City pursuant to a first amendment to lease and option to purchase (the "First Amendment to Lease"); and,

WHEREAS, The Office of Environmental Review of the Department of City Planning has conducted the appropriate environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") (Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.) and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Admin. Code Sections 15000 et seq.) and has determined that the Project is categorically exempt under Public Resources Code Section 21085 and Guidelines Sections 15301-15303; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of City Planning has determined that the Project is consistent with the Eight Priority Policies under Planning Code Section 101.0; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco (the "Board of Supervisors") as follows:

Section 1. <u>Asset Transfer; Description of Property</u>. The lease financing transaction related to the Series 1999-I Bonds for the construction and acquisition of the Emergency Radio System hereby approved involves the lease and leaseback by the City of the following real property under the jurisdiction of the indicated City Commissions, which, pursuant to the First Amendment to Site Lease and the First Amendment to Lease, shall be included in the description of the Property thereunder.

The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the form of the First Supplemental Indenture among the Corporation, the City and the Trustee, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 981926. The Controller of the City (the "Controller") is hereby authorized to execute the First Supplemental Indenture, in substantially the form presented to the Board of Supervisors, with such modifications, changes, or additions as the Controller may make or approve in accordance with Section 6 hereof.

Section 5. Approval of Continuing Disclosure Certificate. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the form of the Continuing Disclosure Certificate (the "Continuing Disclosure Certificate") by the City, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 981926. The Controller is hereby authorized to execute the Continuing Disclosure Certificate, in substantially the form presented to the Board of Supervisors, with such modifications, changes, or additions as the Controller may make or approve in accordance with Section 6 hereof.

Section 6. <u>Modification, Changes and Additions</u>. Section 7. Approval of Issuance of Bonds. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the issuance by the Corporation of not to exceed \$18,750,000 aggregate principal amount of City and County of San Francisco Finance Corporation Lease Revenue Bonds, Series 1999-I (Citywide Emergency Radio System) to be primarily secured by base rental payments to be made by the City pursuant to the Lease, as amended by the First Amendment to Lease; provided, however that in no event shall the interest rate on any Series 1999-I Bond exceed 12%.

Section 8. Additional Authority. The Mayor, the City Attorney, the Controller, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the other officers of the City and their duly authorized deputies and agents are hereby authorized, jointly and severally, to execute and deliver such certificates, requests or other documents, including, but not limited to, certificates relating to the official statement for the Bonds in preliminary or final form or to other offering material relating to the Bonds and certificates and documents relating to obtaining bond insurance for the Bonds, as they may deem necessary or desirable to facilitate the execution and delivery by the City of the First Amendment to Lease, the First Amendment to Site Lease and the First
