Resolution Urging the California State Legislature to repeal Section 1569-147 1569.147 of the Health and Safety Code to allow local governments to limit the annual rent increase imposed on occupied units of licensed residential care facilities for the elderly.

WHEREAS, Increasing numbers of senior citizens live in residential care facilities for the elderly; and

WHEREAS, Senior citizens tend to live on fixed incomes which increase, if at all, only to the extent of a small cost-of-living adjustment each year; and

WHEREAS, Residential care facilities for the elderly are free to increase their rent by any amount they see fit without restriction; and

WHEREAS, Ongoing annual rent increases greater than the cost-of-living adjustments to retirement incomes force many seniors to move out of the residential care facilities into which they had moved expecting to be able to spend the rest their lives in peace; and

WHEREAS, Local governments are prohibited by section 1569-147 1569.147 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California from imposing rent controls on licensed residential care facilities for the elderly; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors call upon the San Francisco delegation to the State Legislature to sponsor legislation that would repeal Section 1569-147 1569.147 of the Health and Safety Code so as to allow local governments to limit the annual rent increase imposed on occupied units of licensed residential care facilities for the elderly to the percentage by which the cost of living increased in that jurisdiction in the preceding year; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon adoption of this resolution, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall transmit copies to members of San Francisco's state legislative delegation.
