Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community Behavioral Health Services (DPH – CBHS) to accept and expend a new 24-month grant in the amount of \$377,345, from the Mylan Settlement Fund (State of Connecticut, et al. v. Mylan Laboratories), to provide services for patients with anxiety disorders; for the period of June 1, 2007 through May 31, 2009.

WHEREAS, DPH - CBHS was awarded a new grant from the Mylan Settlement Fund in the amount of \$377,345 to improve services for patients with anxiety disorders; and,

WHEREAS, The goals of this project are to a) improve the ability of primary care physicians to identify patients suffering from anxiety disorders, b) increase access of these patients to psychiatric evaluations, and c) enable patients with anxiety disorders to receive appropriate medication and treatment; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070454; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant includes funds for part-time personnel, including reimbursement for an existing position (Assistant Health Educator, Job Class 2819 at .15 FTE) and the hiring of a new position (Senior Physician Specialist, Job Class 2232 at .30 FTE), for the period of July 1, 2007 to May 31, 2009; an ASO amendment is not required because the new position will be approved through the DPH budget process, with a start date in FY 2007-08; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$14,090; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH - CBHS, is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$377,345 from the Mylan Settlement Fund; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when the agreement expires.
