## Sec. 106A.3.2.5 Hunters Point Shipyard

Hunters Point Shipyard *Parcel A*, which involves *the subsurface* disturbance *of at least 50 cubic* yards (38.23m3) of soil or the extraction or management of groundwater, except where such permit is for purposes of environmental characterization, and except, in the case of property determined by the applicable ROD to be suitable for unrestricted residential use, where such permit involves subsurface disturbance of less than 50 cubic yards (38.23m3) of soil, shall comply with the requirements of Article 31 of the Health Code. Hunters Point Shipyard *Parcel A* is that area of the City and County of San Francisco shown on Figure 1-2, \_\_\_\_\_ Article 31 Map - Figure 1, which is maintained for public distribution by the Building Official. 
