5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
6 of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated
7 person(s) to serve as member(s) of the Hazardous Materials Advisory
8 Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1105 of the San
9 Francisco Municipal Code (Health Code) for the term specified:

11 Jennifer Mann, (Seat No. 5, must be epidemiologist, for a new
12 four-year term beginning July 1, 1996, ending July 1, 2000;

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the
2 following findings:

- 3 1. The membership of the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee
4 is required to include one representative that is an
5 epidemiologist.
- 6 2. Applicant Jennifer Mann, a new appointee, who is not a
7 resident of San Francisco, is an epidemiologist for the
8 Health Department of the City and County of San Francisco,
9 with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the
10 Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee.
- 11 3. The Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee has attempted to
12 fill the position, for which Jennifer Mann was nominated,
13 with an individual who is a City resident and who has the
14 specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been
15 unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has
16 certified that Jennifer Mann is qualified to serve as the
17 epidemiologist on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee.
- 18 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors
19 concludes that there is no other possible representative, who
20 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific
21 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this
22 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Committee at
23 this time; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the
2 residency requirement for Jennifer Mann, as allowed in cases where no
3 qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to
4 Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed
5 to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by
6 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the
7 City and County of San Francisco.


