3 THEIR EFFORTS TO INCREASE MINORITY AND WOMEN LENDING GOALS

5 WHEREAS, Under the leadership of Aida Alvarez, the Small Business Administration  
6 has embarked upon several programs to increase opportunities for women and minority-  
7 owned firms; and,

8 WHEREAS, The Small Business Administration plans to double SBA loan guarantees  
9 to African American-owned businesses by the year 2000, to \$588 million; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Small Business Administration plans to increase loans to Hispanic  
11 firms to \$948 million, or 54% more than fiscal year 1997; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Small Business Administration has announced plans to assist  
13 women-owned businesses in winning more federal contracts; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Small Business Administration has established a pilot program to  
15 boost federal contracts to businesses with fewer than 15 employees; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Small Business Administration has signed partnership agreements  
17 with the National Association of Development Companies, the National Minority Supplier  
18 Development Council, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, and  
19 11 major women's organizations, representing more than two million business and  
20 professional women; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 commends Aida Alvarez and the Small Business Administration for their efforts to increase  
23 minority and women lending goals; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board transmit a copy of this resolution  
25 to Aida Alvarez, Administrator of the Small Business Administration.


