WHEREAS, By reducing the 28-page application form, allowing automated payment of premiums, and providing materials in Spanish and other languages, more families will enroll their children in the Healthy Families Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Healthy Families Program to implement changes in the administration of the program that will encourage the enrollment of additional children; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board transmit a copy of this resolution to the Healthy Families Program.
