APPROVING THE OCTAVIA BOULEVARD ALTERNATIVE FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE CENTRAL FREEWAY, WITHDRAWING AUTHORIZATION FOR CALTRANS TO ENACT THE CENTRAL FREEWAY REPLACEMENT PROJECT ACT OF 1997, REPEALING BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION #1073-97, REINSTATING BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION #541-92, URGING CALTRANS TO PROCEED IMMEDIATELY WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CENTRAL FREEWAY REPLACEMENT PROJECT ACT OF 1998 AND URGING CALTRANS TO TAKE DOWN THE EXISTING STRUCTURE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, On November 3, 1998, San Francisco voters demonstrated their support for the Octavia Boulevard alternative for replacement of the Central Freeway by passing Proposition E; and,

WHEREAS, The vote on Proposition E was the first time San Franciscans had the opportunity to choose between two clearly defined alternatives for replacing the Central Freeway; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition E called for the City of San Francisco to authorize Caltrans to replace the Central Freeway with an elevated structure descending to ground level south of Market Street and thence a ground-level boulevard from Market along Octavia Street; and,

WHEREAS, The Octavia Boulevard plan will allow traffic to disperse north and west more quickly and efficiently, thus ameliorating traffic congestion problems not addressed by the Central Freeway Replacement Project Act of 1997; and,

SUPERVISORS BIERMAN, KATZ, LENO, AMMIANO, BROWN, MEDINA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, The Octavia Boulevard plan upholds the intent of Board of Supervisors Resolution #541-92, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File #171-92-003, declaring it the policy of the City and County of San Francisco not to build any new aboveground ramps north of Fell Street to replace those sections of the Central Freeway damaged by the Loma Prieta earthquake of 1989; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition E called for repeal of 1997's Proposition H, the Central Freeway Replacement Project Act of 1997 and Board of Supervisors Resolution #1073-97 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File #85-97-6; and,

WHEREAS, Caltrans has concerns about the seismic safety of the existing structure; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors upholds the will of the people of San Francisco and approves the Octavia Boulevard alternative for replacement of the Central Freeway; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors withdraws authorization for Caltrans to enact the Central Freeway Replacement Project Act of 1997; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors repeals Board of Supervisors Resolution #1073-97 and reinstates Board of Supervisors Resolution #541-92; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges Caltrans to proceed immediately with implementation of the Central Freeway Replacement Project Act of 1998; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges Caltrans to take down the existing structure as soon as possible to eliminate the threat of seismic hazard without incurring further retrofit expenditures.
