AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR EMERGENCY RESTORATION OF SUPPORTING SOIL AROUND MOCCASIN NEWARK TRANSMISSION LINE TOWER FOOTINGS AND REPAIR TO ACCESS ROADS IN CORRAL HOLLOW.

WHEREAS, On February 13, 1998, the President of the Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with Section 6.30(1) of the San Francisco Administrative Code, declared the existence of an emergency condition requiring immediate repairs to damage resulting from erosion of soil from around some Moccasin Newark Transmission Line Tower Footings and Access Roads in Corral Hollow caused by unusually intense and prolonged rainfall, which washed out access roads and eroded the soil; and,

WHEREAS, PUC Staff has made an assessment of damage, and had estimated that work estimated at \$750,000 is required to restore the access roads and replace the surcharge over the tower footings; and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No.98-0260, on October 27, 1998, the Public Utilities
Commission ratified the Declaration of Emergency made by the President of the Commission
on February 13, 1998, and requested the Board of Supervisors to adopt a resolution
approving expenditure of funds up to \$750,000 to repair the damage to the Hetch Hetchy
transmission tower footings and access roads in Corral Hollow caused by the flooding; and

WHEREAS, Funding for repairs is currently available in Hetch Hetchy's Project No. CUH76224 Emergency Erosion Control, Famis Index Code 527624; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of up to \$750,000 by the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power for emergency repairs to restore access roads, replace soil eroded from around transmission line tower footings, and provide for future stream flow diversion in the Corral Hollow area following severe storms and high creek flows in January and February 1998.
