- 2. Applicant Alice Glasner, the incumbent, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is City Planning Department's choice as their representative, and is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee.
- 3. The Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Alice Glasner was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Alice Glasner is qualified to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Alice Glasner, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
