WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA requires the City to comply with the terms of an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070895, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$8,250 from the CDFA; and, be it
