WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA and CDPR require the City to comply with the terms of two separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070897 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget for both grants; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend two grants in the total amount of \$4,948.18 from the CDFA and CDPR; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the budget of the two Agreements; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED. That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreements on behalf of the City.
