WHEREAS, The City has vacated the subject property and it has been used by the San Francisco Unified School District ("SFUSD") since 1976 and SFUSD constructed a replacement street (Mistral St.) to accommodate Treat Ave. traffic; and

WHEREAS, The powers to manage and control school property in San Francisco are vested in the governing board of the San Francisco Unified School District and this governing board has approved the construction of a technical high school which will encroach upon the vacated Treat Ave. property; and

WHEREAS, The above described property has not been converted to other public uses under circumstances which would estop the SFUSD from claiming control over use of such property, nor which would give the City a license to use the property for such public purposes; and

981841 , that the conveyance of the above described property by quitclaim deed from the City to the SFUSD is in conformity with the City's General Plan and consistent with the Eight Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED; That the Director of Property is hereby authorized and directed to execute a quitclaim deed for the amount of one (1) dollar to the SFUSD of the real property in San Francisco, known as a portion of Assessor's Block 3593, Lot 40, formerly Treat Avenue north of 20th Street, as such property is more particularly described in the Quitclaim Deed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 981841; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED; That the Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein, as though fully set forth, the findings made by the Planning Department, by its letter dated August 28, 1998, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 981841, that such conveyance is in conformity with the City's General Plan and consistent with the Eight Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1.
