[Intent to Vacate and Sell - Portion of 23rd Street]

DECLARING INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO VACATE AND SELL A PORTION OF 23RD STREET LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE, SETTING THE HEARING DATE FOR ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE PROPOSED VACATION AND SALE, MAKING FINDINGS OF GENERAL PLAN CONFORMANCE AND CONSISTENCY WITH PLANNING CODE SECTION 101.1, AND AUTHORIZING OTHER OFFICIAL ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Food Bank (the "Food Bank"), owner of the property located at 900 Pennsylvania Avenue, planned to construct a new warehouse facility on such site; and

WHEREAS, The Food Bank requested that a portion of 23rd Street, which adjoins the warehouse site, be vacated and sold to the Food Bank (the "Subject Area") to be used for driveway and landscaping purposes; and

WHEREAS, The Subject Area is shown on the Department of Public Works SUR Drawing No. 1196, Parcel No. 2, dated November 19, 1996, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1765; and

WHEREAS, By letter dated April 30, 1997, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1765 the Department of Public Works reported its findings that the Subject Area is no longer needed for present or prospective street purposes; and

WHEREAS, A public utility easement will be reserved for use, installation, maintenance, repair [REAL ESTATE]

and replacement of existing PG&E gas and electric facilities as well as future utility installations by other parties; and

WHEREAS, There is no potential user of the Subject Area other than the Food Bank; and WHEREAS, The Food Bank provides a public service to people in need by annually distributing 10 million pounds of food to said people and so a nominal purchase price of \$1.00 is recommended; and

WHEREAS, By letter dated December 24, 1996, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1765, the Department of City Planning reported its findings that the proposed vacation of the Subject Area is in conformity with City's General Plan and consistent with the Eight Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors intends to sell the Subject Area to the Food Bank and to authorize the Director of Property to execute and deliver any and all necessary documents and instruments to effectuate such sale, including a purchase agreement and quitclaim deed on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That, pursuant to Section 8320 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it is its intention to order the vacation of a portion of 23rd Street, located on the west side of Pennsylvania Avenue, as described in the aforesaid drawing on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1765 (the "Subject Area"); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the vacation proceeding of said Subject Area is conducted under the general vacation procedures of the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law (Streets and Highways Code Sections 8320 et seq.); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, All actions authorized by this Resolution and heretofore taken by any City official in connection with the vacation contemplated herein are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed by this Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to transmit to the Department of Public Works, a certified copy of this Resolution, and the Department of Public Works is hereby directed to publish or post this Resolution in the manner required by law and to give notice of the hearing of such contemplated action in the manner required by law.
