WHEREAS, Dr. Mark Blank and Yumi Blank, residents of the Lakeside Property

Owners Association, recently discovered that the Association bylaws contained a provision barring non-whites from living in the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, This unconscionable provision was placed in the bylaws in 1939 and inexplicably remained intact ever since; and

WHEREAS, Such racial restrictions are prohibited by the federal Fair Housing Act but their mere presence is offense and discriminatory; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) acted quickly to press reports about the provision in the Lakeside Property Owners Association bylaws and worked to negotiate its removal; and

WHEREAS, HUD has also announced that its budget for anti-discrimination in housing has increased in FY1998 to \$40 from \$30 million the previous year; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby commends HUD and its staff for its prompt work in negotiating the removal of the discriminatory and offensive provision in the Lakeside Property Owners Association bylaws.
