## CONDEMNING THE ANTI-GAY MOTIVATED MURDER OF MATTHEW SHEPARD AND URGING THE WYOMING LEGISLATURE TO ADOPT A HATE CRIMES STATUTE WHICH INCLUDES SEXUAL ORIENTATION

WHEREAS, Matthew Shepard, a 22 year old gay University of Wyoming student was robbed, beaten, burned, and tied to a fence-post on Wednesday, October 7, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, Matthew Shepard was found unconscious after enduring twelve hours exposed to the elements in near freezing temperatures; and,

WHEREAS, Matthew Shepard succumbed to his injuries on Monday, October 12, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, The suspected perpetrators of the hate motivated murder made anti-gay comments about the victim to their accessories; and,

WHEREAS, Commander O'Malley of the local Wyoming police department stated that the victim was chosen in part because of his sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, Many states, including California, have hate crimes laws which provide prison sentencing guidelines which lengthen a jail term for crimes against persons which were motivated by perpetrators hatred of the victim's sexual orientation, be it homosexual or heterosexual; and,

WHEREAS, California's hate crimes statute allows for prosecution of crimes motivated by hatred of heterosexuals as well as homosexuals, thus providing no special rights for homosexuals; and,

WHEREAS, The state of Wyoming has no hate crimes statue; and,

WHEREAS, The citizens of the City and County of San Francisco deplore hateful attacks against lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender persons; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco condemns the murder of Matthew Shepard
