7 ORGANIZED TO MAKE ABUSE NON-EXISTENT (W.O.M.A.N. Inc.) FOR A
8 VICTIM'S ADVOCATE POSITION.

11 WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires
12 to undertake a certain project designated "Violence Against Women-Law Enforcement
13 Specialized Units Program" (herein after referred to as "VAWLESUP") funded from
14 funds made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (herein after
15 referred to as OCJP) for the reduction of repeat domestic violence against women; and

18 WHEREAS, W.O.M.A.N Inc. agrees to provide an in-kind match of THIRTY
19 SEVEN THOUSAND (\$37,000.00) DOLLARS to fund a Victim's Advocate position.
20 This Victim's Advocate will partner with the Domestic Violence Inspector to deliver
21 services to women who have been victims of repeated domestic violence; now therefore
22 be it

24 RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is
25 authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of


San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions,
amendments thereof; and be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the board of Supervisors hereby waive indirect costs;
and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
Francisco is authorized to accept and expend funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED
TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$110,000.00) made available through The Office of
Criminal Justice Planning for the project known as "VAWLESUP", and agreeing to
accept an In-Kind match of THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND (\$37,000.00) DOLLARS.




