WHEREAS, W.O.M.A.N Inc. agrees to provide an in-kind match of THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND (\$37,000.00) DOLLARS to fund a Victim's Advocate position. This Victim's Advocate will partner with the Domestic Violence Inspector to deliver services to women who have been victims of repeated domestic violence; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of

San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions, amendments thereof; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for and such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the board of Supervisors hereby waive indirect costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to accept and expend funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$110,000.00) made available through The Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the project known as "VAWLESUP", and agreeing to accept an In-Kind match of THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND (\$37,000.00) DOLLARS.
