AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, POPULATION HEALTH AND PREVENTION DIVISION, COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SAFETY, TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS OF \$358,910 FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES TO PROVIDE HIV-1 VIRAL LOAD TESTS AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WHICH INCLUDES INDEMNIFICATION AND RIGHTS IN DATA CLAUSES AND WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES; WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been awarded a grant from The California Department of Health Services in the amount of \$358,910 to provide HIV Viral Load Tests for AIDS Drug Assistance Program eligible clients from Early Intervention Program sites; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The California Department of Health Services requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1606; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Health Services does not allow for indirect costs for this program; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement contains certain provisions described below, which require the approval of the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the Department of Public Health, on behalf of the City, to enter into the Agreement in order to receive and expend the grant funds for this and any future years; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect costs; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies The California Department of Health Services; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the Agreement pursuant to which the City agrees to grant a royalty-free and nonexclusive license for the use of data developed under the contract; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification of the City by The California Department of Health Services for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code: and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into similar agreements with The California Department of Health Services if the grant recurs or is renewed.
