2 AUTHORIZING, ^{RETROACTIVELY,} ~~THE~~ PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL OF SAN FRANCISCO, INC. TO
3 ACCEPT AND EXPEND APPROXIMATELY \$550,000 OF REFUGEE FUNDS FOR AN
4 ELDERLY REFUGEE PROJECT IN LINE WITH THE REFUGEE COUNTY PLAN.

5 WHEREAS, The Private Industry Council of San Francisco, Inc. (PIC), by
6 authorization of this Board of Supervisors acts with the approval of the Department of
7 Human Services for the City and County of San Francisco in administering federal
8 Refugee funds awarded to San Francisco; and

9 WHEREAS, The staff of the PIC, in consultation with the Refugee Committee of the
10 Private Industry Council, submitted a proposal to the federal Office of Refugee
11 Resettlement (ORR) to serve elderly refugees who may be impacted by Welfare Reform;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, The PIC will coordinate the use of these funds with other funding
14 sources to aid this group; and

15 WHEREAS, these funds could be used in carrying out recommendations of the
16 Mayor's Welfare Reform Task Force for older individuals; now therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, The President of the PIC is authorized ~~by~~ the Board of Supervisors to
19 accept and expend \$550,000 of refugee funds for elderly refugees as described in the
20 1998 Refugee County Plan.


