[Crane Operator Certification]

URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE TO REQUIRE THE CERTIFICATION OF OPERATORS OF CRANES AND OTHER HOISTING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, The State of California requires cranes and other hoisting equipment to be tested, certified, and inspected regularly; and,

WHEREAS, Recent accidents in the City and County of San Francisco involving cranes underscore the need for comprehensive safety regulations involving the inspection, maintenance, and operation of cranes and other hoisting equipment; and,

WHEREAS, The State of California does not require operators of cranes and other hoisting equipment to be certified; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the California State Legislature to develop testing and examination standards evidencing qualification to operate cranes and other hoisting equipment; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the California State Legislature to require operators of cranes and other hoisting equipment to be certified; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the State Legislature, as well as Governor Pete Wilson, with a request they all take action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
