[Denouncing California Defense of Marriage Act]

DENOUNCING THE SUBMISSION OF PETITIONS TO PLACE THE CALIFORNIA DEFENSE OF MARRIAGE ACT ON THE BALLOT AS A STATE-WIDE INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, San Francisco respects and values its lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has demonstrated its respect for the loving relationships of same sex couples by performing same sex marriages; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco allows for domestic partnerships; and,

WHEREAS, State Senator Peter Knight has submitted petitions for an initiative that would outlaw gay marriage in California; and,

WHEREAS, This initiative, known as the California Defense of Marriage Act, would prohibit the state of California from the honoring the marriages of same sex couples who married in other states; and,

WHEREAS, The California Defense of Marriage Act would likely violate the full faith and credit clause of the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, The California Defense of Marriage Act would conflict with both state and federal equal protection laws; and,

WHEREAS, The California Defense of Marriage Act would infringe on the rights of Californians; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco denounces the proposed California Defense of Marriage Act initiative; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the

State Legislature, as well as Governor Pete Wilson, with a request they take all action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
