

1 [Bicycle Legislation - Extension of Planning Commission Review Period]

2 EXTENDING THE PRESCRIBED TIME WITHIN WHICH THE PLANNING COMMISSION
3 MAY RENDER ITS DECISION ON THE PROPOSED BICYCLE TRANSIT ENHANCEMENT
4 PLAN ORDINANCE, FOR AN ADDITIONAL 45 DAY PERIOD ENDING ON NOVEMBER 13,
5 1998.

6 WHEREAS, On April 6, 1998, the Board of Supervisors initiated the process to amend
7 the Municipal Code, Part II, Chapter II (Planning Code), when the Honorable Leslie Katz
8 introduced a proposed ordinance, entitled the "Bicycle Transit Enhancement Plan," a copy of
9 which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-0564; and,

10 WHEREAS, The proposed ordinance would amend Article 1.5 of the Planning Code
11 with respect to general standards as to location and arrangement of off-street parking, bicycle
12 parking requirements for city-owned and leased buildings, bicycle parking requirements for
13 city-owned parking garages and privately-owned parking garages as well as requirements for
14 shower and locker facilities in new commercial and industrial buildings and existing buildings
15 undergoing major renovations; and,

16 WHEREAS, On July 1, 1998, the proposed ordinance, as amended by substitute
17 legislation on June 29, 1998, was referred to the Planning Commission, which is currently
18 reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

19 WHEREAS, Section 306.4(d) of the Planning Code requires that the Planning
20 Commission render a decision regarding proposed amendments to the Planning Code within
21 90 days from the date of referral of such amendments to the Planning Commission; and

22 WHEREAS, the current 90 day period for the Planning Commission's review of the
23 proposed amendments expires on September 29, 1998; and

24 WHEREAS, The Zoning Administrator has requested additional time to review the
25 proposed ordinance; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
2 resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
3 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of
4 Supervisors; and,

5 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning
6 Commission an additional 90 days to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision;
7 now, therefore, be it


8 RESOLVED, That by this resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
