AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ENTER INTO A SUBCONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,846 WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR, TO COLLABORATE IN THE "CONNIE WOFSY WOMENS HIV STUDY" TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SCIENTIFIC CONDUCT OF THIS PROJECT, AND WHICH INCLUDES INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSES AND WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES; RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 1998.

WHEREAS, The University of California has received funds through the National Institutes of Health, Department of Health and Human Services, for a project entitled: the "Connie Wofsy Womens HIV Study"; and

WHEREAS, The University of California, as the primary contractor, has requested the that the San Francisco City and County Department of Public Health, enter into a subcontract to participate in this project; and

WHEREAS, The subcontract specifies that Herminia Palacio, M.D., is designated as the Project Director who shall be responsible for the scientific conduct of the project covered by this Agreement during the term of the subcontract; and;

WHEREAS, The University of California has agreed to reimburse the San Francisco City and County Department of Public Health in the amount of \$13,846, which includes indirect costs in the amount of \$2,587 based on 22.98% of salary under the terms of this subcontract; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, the University of California requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1498__; and

WHEREAS, The University of California has indicated that it will not agree to any modification to the form of the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement contains certain provisions described below, which require the approval of the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the Department of Public Health, on behalf of the City, to enter into the agreement in order to receive and expend the funds for this and any future years; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco City and County Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter into a subcontract in the amount of \$13,846 with the University of California, the Primary Contractor, to be responsible for the scientific conduct of the project covered by this Agreement; retroactive to July 1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies University of California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification of the City by the University of California for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57(c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57(a) of the Administrative Code; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into similar agreements with the University of California if the contract is renewed.
