WHEREAS, Rivera Street runs through a residential neighborhood with a speed limit of 25 miles per hour; and,

WHEREAS, Currently, at the intersection of Rivera Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, there are stop signs slowing down traffic traveling on 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, but there are no stop signs directed at traffic traveling on Rivera Street; and,

WHEREAS, Neighbors have reported that the intersection of Rivera Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue is a busy intersection that has been the site of many auto accidents and near-misses; and,

WHEREAS, On March 21, 2000, a driver speeding on Rivera Street, and unimpeded by a stop sign, caused an injury accident that also damaged three vehicles, 2 U.S. Postal Service mail boxes, and a home at the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Rivera Street; and,

WHEREAS, Implementing a four-way stop at Rivera Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue will provide some redress for neighbors living near this accident-prone intersection; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to install stop signs on Rivera Street at its intersection with 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue to improve the traffic safety in the area; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to install the stop signs within 30 days after the Mayor signs the legislation.
