[AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY RECONSTRUCTION OF THE RETAINING WALL AT CLAYTON STREET]

FINDING AND DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY EXISTS AT CLAYTON STREET;
AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TAKE
NECESSARY MEASURES IN THE MOST EXPEDITIOUS MANNER TO PROTECT THE
PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, WELFARE, AND PROPERTY OF THE CITIZENS OF SAN
FRANCISCO FROM THE DANGEROUS CONDITION CREATED BY THE FAILURE OF THE
RETAINING WALL AT CLAYTON STREET; AND, BECAUSE OF THIS EMERGENCY,
AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS OF INDEMNITY.

WHEREAS, Extensive rains during the 1997-1998 rainy season caused the failure of a retaining wall at Clayton Street, between <a href="Twin Peaks Boulevard and Greystone Terrace">Twin Peaks Boulevard and Greystone Terrace</a>
Corbett Avenue and Pemberton-Place; and,

WHEREAS, The failure of the retaining wall has created a dangerous condition which threatens the public safety, health, welfare, and property of the citizens of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Pubic Works has determined that because of the approaching rainy season, the dangerous condition at Clayton Street is an emergency which requires the City to take immediate remedial action to reconstruct the retaining wall before the next rainy season; and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Pubic Works has determined that the cost of an emergency reconstruction of the retaining wall is three hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$347,500); and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of the Public Works has determined that it is at best extremely difficult to retain necessary consultants and contractors to assist the City in this emergency without an agreement of indemnity; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors finds and declares that an emergency exists at Clayton Street, between Twin Peaks Boulevard and Greystone Terrace, the emergency is due to the dangerous condition resulting from the failure of the retaining wall and the approaching rainy season, and that the emergency requires that prompt remedial action be taken to safeguard the lives, safety and property of the citizens of the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to take all necessary emergency measures in the most expeditious manner to protect the public safety, health, welfare, and property of the citizens of the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to enter into agreements to hire necessary consultants and contractors, which agreements may contain an indemnification provision indemnifying the consultants and contractors from claims or other losses, except those caused by or resulting from the gross negligence or intentional acts or omissions of the consultants or contractors, their officers, agents, or employees; and be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to use money from the Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Project Funds, to perform the necessary work which is expected to cost approximately three hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$347,500); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney and the Department of Public Works are requested to seek to recover from the adjacent property owners, to the extent possible, the property owner's fair share of the expenses required to restore the retaining wall.
