[Three year fee waiver for minors at Balboa Swimming Pool.]

WHEREAS, Outer Mission/Excelsior is the second largest neighborhood in terms of children under the age of 18 with 14, 119 residing in the district; and,

WHEREAS, The three year fee waiver will allow easy pool access to families living in the neighborhood, of which about 8-12% live below the proverty line; and,

WHEREAS, An identical proposal was passed by the Board of Supervisors for the North Beach Swimming Pool, demonstrating San Francisco's ability to absorb the cost of the current \$0.50 charge for minors; and,

WHEREAS, In 1999 the Balboa Swimming Pool only generated \$5, 524 in revenue from the \$0.50 charge to children 17 and under; and,

WHEREAS, On November 6, 2000, the San Francisco Youth Commission urged the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to waive said fees for minors through Resolution No. 00-02; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Recreation & Park Commission to waive all fees to minors ages 17 and under for three years at the Balboa Swimming Pool.
