Resolution declaring December 8, 2000 to be "Olympic Dragon Day" in San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The City of Beijing in the People's Republic of China is seeking to host the 2008 Olympic Games; and,

WHEREAS, A group of Chinese Americans in the San Francisco Bay Area have organized an Alliance in Support of Beijing Olympics 2008 ("the Alliance") to assist in Beijing's Olympic bid; and,

WHEREAS, Hosting the Olympic Games will be a source of national pride to both Chinese Americans and Chinese residing in the People's Republic of China; and,

WHEREAS, The Alliance is directing its efforts to publicize the work of San Francisco-based artist Zhao Jian-Hai and his dramatic earth art project scheduled to be unveiled at the Great Wall of China in May 2001; and,

WHEREAS, Zhao Jian-Hai's performance art piece involves the unfurling of a 10,000 meter silk-screened canvas containing two thousand eight Olympic Dragon images in what will be the longest such work in the world; and,

WHEREAS, The Olympic Dragon images will be held by 4,000 participants at the art piece's unveiling; and,

WHEREAS, After the performance, Zhao Jian-Hai's Olympic Dragon will be presented to the International Olympic Committee, China's National Olympic Committee, the diplomatic community in Beijing, the Guiness Book of World Records, and sponsors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby declares December 8, 2000 to be "Olympic Dragon Day" in San Francisco.
