WHEREAS, Alice B. Toklas is a symbol of unwavering strength and leadership for the Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender community; and,

WHEREAS. The community has brought forward this proposal and has expressed overwhelming support for an Alice B. Toklas Place in recognition of her importance to the Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender Community; and,

WHEREAS, At a time when women's lives were clearly identified through men, Alice B. Toklas' and Gertrude Stein's relationship continues to be a source of inspiration for those who celebrate diversity and stand up for civil and human rights; and,

WHEREAS Alice B. Toklas spent many years in San Francisco, living at this location with her family; and,

WHEREAS, Myrtle Street is an alley that runs east to west from Van Ness Avenue to Polk Street; and,

WHEREAS, Burnham Pacific Properties, Inc., the developer of the new theater complex at the site, which would be the sole property affected, is very supportive of the proposal to rename Myrtle Street to Alice B. Toklas Place; and,

WHEREAS, The act of renaming streets in this City is very rare and is reserved for unique circumstances; and,

WHEREAS, Alice B. Toklas Place is a unique and significant proposal because of Toklas' profound literary and cultural contributions to the community; and,

WHEREAS, Alice B. Toklas Place would also be unique because it would have no impact on the current residences on the adjoining two blocks of this three block alley which will retain Myrtle as their street name; now, therefore, be it
