AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$72,450 FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 42000 authorizes the California Integrated Waste Management Board to conduct market development activities to strengthen demand by manufacturers and end-use consumers for recyclable materials collected by municipalities, nonprofit organizations, and private entities; and,

WHEREAS, the concept of *Sustainable Buildings*, also referred to as *Green Buildings*, is an integrated approach which encompasses integrated waste management objectives such as building material efficiency, construction and demolition waste reduction, and maximization of reused- and recycled-content building and landscaping materials; and,

WHEREAS, on May 24, 1999, the Board of Supervisors passed the Resource Efficient City Building Ordinance 148-99, which directed the Department of the Environment to coordinate a pilot program of green design practices for new construction in City facilities and to include training for City design staff; and,

WHEREAS, on September 25th, 2000, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved a resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Environment to apply for \$72,450 from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the development of a Green Building tool kit and training workshops; and,

WHEREAS, on October 18th, 2000 the California Integrated Waste Management Board approved the awarding of \$72,450 to San Francisco for the development of a Green Building toolkit and training workshops; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it
