WHEREAS, The Purchaser and Contractor propose to enter into a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement to extend the time for performance of the contract for a period of six (6) months, or to April 30, 2007, to continue the performance of these essential hauling services while the City pursues a competitive solicitation for a new contract for the work; and

WHEREAS, The extension of time would increase the total compensation under the contract to an amount not to exceed \$10,480,000 and San Francisco Charter Section 9.118(b) provides that agreements entered into by a department, board or commission requiring anticipated expenditures by the City and County of ten million dollars, shall be subject to approval of the Board of Supervisors by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement and the proposed Fourth Amendment are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 061391, which are hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it
