14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by
16 reference herein as though fully set forth the Planning Department findings in its letter
17 dated September 20, 2007. Said letter stated the actions contemplated herein are
18 consistent with the General Plan and in conformance with the Eight Priority Policies of
19 Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of
20 Supervisors File No. 071581

21 Section 2. In the abovementioned letter, the Planning Department also determined
22 that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California
23 Environmental Quality ACT (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.).
24 Said determination is incorporated herein by reference.

25 Section 3. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ No. 177,191, a
copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 071581


ORDINANCE NO.

1 , Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of
2 Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General
3 Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to
4 read as follows:

5 Section 1576. The official sidewalk width on the northerly side of Townsend
6 Street between 6th and 7th Streets shall be 10 feet.

7 Section 4. Julia Liu c/o 590 Townsend Street, as is necessary as a result of this
8 Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City Departments
9 for the relocation, modification, or any affected public facilities. Any required relocation,
10 modification, or both of said facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San
11 Francisco.






