WHEREAS, The purpose of this committee is for both the City and the labor representatives to jointly discuss how the City and County of San Francisco will address the estimated $\$ 4.9$ billion unfunded 30 year liability owed by the City in future retiree health benefits; and

WHEREAS, The Joint City-Labor GASB committee does not include any existing retirees covered by the City's retirement system; and,

WHEREAS, Although it would be legally impermissible to in any way change or amend existing retiree benefits, the gravity of the discussion surrounding a $\$ 4.9$ billion unfunded liability undoubtedly creates a genuine concern among the current retiree population; and, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Joint City-Labor GASB committee to ensure the continuity and full protection of all existing benefits currently enjoyed by existing retirees covered by the San Francisco retirement system; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Joint City-Labor GASB committee to invite representatives of existing retirees to any meetings discussing GASB issues.
