Resolution urging Albertson's Inc. not to close the Albertson's supermarket located in the Oceanview Village development.

WHEREAS, Albertson's Inc. announced on June 6, 2006, a plan to close 37 Northern California locations by early August, including the branch located at 3995 Alemany Boulevard in the Oceanview-Merced-Ingleside community; and,

WHEREAS, Such an action would leave the OMI community without a full-service supermarket; and,

WHEREAS, A great number of the residents in the surrounding areas are lowincome working families and senior citizens without an automobile; and,

WHEREAS, The lack of a neighborhood grocery store would produce tangible hardships in the lives of these community members; and,

WHEREAS, Since Albertson's is one of the few grocers in the area that accepts food stamps, its absence would hurt San Francisco's most vulnerable citizens; and,

WHEREAS, Albertson's closure would eliminate a potentially significant number of iobs: and.

WHEREAS, As the largest retailer in the Oceanview Village mixed-use development, a vacant Albertson's would be a blight on the development and discourage customers from visiting other commercial tenants in the development and the surrounding business area; and

WHEREAS, When Albertson's opened in March of 2002, it made a commitment to the OMI community that it would serve as an anchor for the Oceanview Village development and as a community grocer; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Albertson's Inc. not to close the Oceanview Village Alerbertson's supermarket; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Albertson's Inc. to make public all financial information regarding the profitability of the Oceanview Village branch; and, be it

Further RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges

Albertson's to work with the City and the community to find an appropriate solution that meets
the needs of the OMI's residents.
