# Resolution enacting and rescinding traffic regulations on various streets.

Divided in Committee 7/17/06

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

#### **BIGYCLE LANES - ESTABLISH**

Sloat Boulevard, both directions, from Skyline Boulevard to The Great Highway.

#### RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT - RESCIND

Sloat Boulevard, eastbound, from Skyline Boulevard to 300 feet westerly.

### RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT EXCEPT MUNI-ESTABLISH-

Sloat-Boulevard, westbound, from 37th Avenue to 39th Avenue; and,

Sloat Boulevard, eastbound, from Skyline Boulevard to 350 feet westerly.

**RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT EXCEPT MUNI AND BICYCLES - ESTABLISH** 

Market Street, eastbound, at 15<sup>th</sup> and Sanchez Streets

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.
