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WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$49,860.49, now therefore be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
