Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Section 1578. The official sidewalk width on the north side of Mission Street west of 3rd Street shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-650, copies of which are in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 080351

Section 4. The San Francisco Redevelopment Agency, as is necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City Departments for the relocation, modification, or any affected public facilities. Any necessary relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San Francisco.

Section 5. (a) The Board of Supervisors acknowledges that the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency's offer of a public access easement over a portion of Jessie Square is intended to offset the loss in sidewalk width due to the sidewalk width change contemplated herein. A copy of said easement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. __080351_____ and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board of Supervisors approves the subject public access easement in substantially the form on file with the Clerk of the Board.

(b) The Board hereby authorizes and Director of Public Works and Director of Real Estate to take any and all actions which they or the City Attorney may deem necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Ordinance (including, without limitation, processing and recordation of the easement contemplated herein).
