Resolution urging the California State Legislature to pass
legislation which would provide to domestic partners holding
property as joint tenants the same protections from
reassessments upon the death of one of the joint tenants as are
currently enjoyed by married couples.

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of members of the Board of Supervisors that properties held by domestic partners as joint tenants in San Francisco are often subject to a reassessment upon the death of one partner; and,

WHEREAS, These reassessments, which can engender significant rises in property tax bills, are carried out pursuant to state law and cannot be prevented by changes in local laws; and

WHEREAS, California state law provides an exception to such reassessments for married couples;

WHEREAS, The exception for married couples on property reassessment shows the State has an interest in protecting couples from significant increases in tax rates upon the death of a partner, but also reveals the discrimination in state law against same sex domestic partners who are not eligible for marriage benefits; and,

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has a special interest in championing the rights of domestic partners, due to the

significant lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities that reside within the City; now, therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the California State

Legislature to pass legislation which would provide to domestic partners holding property as joint tenants the same protections from reassessments upon the death of one of the joint tenants as are currently enjoyed by married couples in similar circumstances; and, be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall send a copy of this resolution to Assemblymembers Carole Migden and Kevin Shelley, as well as to State Senator John Burton.
