[Urging passage of AB540]

Resolution urging the California State Assembly to pass AB540, the Out-of-state Tuition Exemption for Immigrant Students bill.

WHEREAS, The United States Supreme Court decided in Plyler v. Doe (1982) that individuals who hold "green cards" and reside in the United States are entitled to an education in the K-12 system because their parents work and pay taxes regardless of their national status; and,

WHEREAS, Education is not only a basic right for all people, but it supports long term benefits that are in our national interest to provide a better workforce that is capable of meeting national production needs; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco, with its long history of immigration and diverse communities, has a special interest in supporting education for all, regardless of immigration status; and,

WHEREAS, Green card holders who work successfully through the K-12 system and enter California colleges or universities are required to pay out-of-state tuition, effectively forcing them to end their education after high school; and,

WHEREAS, The State of Texas has already set a precedent for long-time immigrants to pay in-state tuition rates for college if the students had been enrolled in high school for at least three years; and,

WHEREAS, AB540, sponsored by Assembly Member Marco Antonio Firebaugh, would exempt undocumented immigrants from paying out-of-state tuition, allowing them to go to college at lower instate rates if the students have attended high school for at least three years and graduated; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Davis vetoed a similar bill last year claiming that it violated federal law, and the section that Davis cited has been amended to address his concerns; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the California State Assembly to pass AB540, the Out-of-state Tuition Exemption for Immigrant Students bill.
