[Urging Disaster Preparedness Testing]

Resolution urging the San Francisco Department of Emergency
Communications and the Office of the Mayor to institute an
interdepartmental disaster preparedness test, and further urging
the Association of Bay Area Governments to begin similar
intergovernmental disaster preparedness testing.

WHEREAS, The United States is currently undergoing profound changes in the nature and frequency of terrorist threats; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco, as one of our nation's premiere cities located in a region that is strategically and economically important, is a potential target of terrorist attack both large and small; and

WHEREAS, New York City, Washington, D.C., and other strategically important locations in our nation have recently suffered terrorist attacks of varied scope and have included both explosive and biological agents; and

WHEREAS, It is city, county, and regional agencies which are on the frontlines of any domestic terrorist threat, and these agencies must have direct lines of communication to facilitate a coordinated response to ensure the safety of the City of San Francisco and the San Francisco Bay Area; and,

WHEREAS, A terrorist attack of regional magnitude would require a coordinated response from hundreds of local and regional agencies and departments; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby urges the San Francisco Department of Emergency Communications and the San Francisco Office of the Mayor to institute a disaster preparedness test across all relevant City departments; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Association of Bay Area Governments to devise and implement a disaster preparedness test of intergovernmental cooperation and response; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall send a copy of this resolution to the Department of Emergency Communications, the Office of the Mayor, and the Association of Bay Area Governments.
