WHEREAS, UCB has agreed to fund DPH's Environmental Health Section (EHS) in the amount of \$7,580, for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved the first year of funding for this project on March 18, 2008, through File Number 080356, Resolution Number 125-08; and,

WHEREAS, These funds will allow DPH-EHS to continue its investigation of Chinatown worker health and safety through a collaboration with the Chinese Progressive Association, the School of Public Health/Labor Occupational Program at UCB, and the Department of Occupational Medicine at UCSF; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, Health Program Coordinator I (Job Class #2589) at .07 FTE, for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the CDC did not send the award letter to UC Berkeley until August 10, 2008, which did not allow enough time for DPH to secure approval before the start date of year two of the project, September 1, 2008; and,
