Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 a.m. each day of the week. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s). (3) The

petitioner shall not permit their patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the area adjacent to the licensed premises. (4) Loitering is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee. (5) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (6) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) years of age shall sell, furnish or deliver alcoholic beverages. (7) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday. (8) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in the portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered and consumed.
