WHEREAS, In September 2007 SFPUC staff submitted a \$8,119,150 grant application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for implementation of a Contamination Warning System Demonstration Pilot Project; and

WHEREAS, The US EPA notified the SFPUC in November 2007 that its application was awarded \$8,119,150 grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the SFPUC received the final grant award offer in March 2008 for the implementation of a Contamination Warning System Demonstration Pilot Project; and

WHEREAS, Funding for the required matching funding is available from the FY 07-08 and proposed FY 08-09 Water Enterprise Operating Budgets; and

WHEREAS, In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) the project is Categorically Excluded (CATEX) from the need to prepare either an environmental assessment or environmental impact statement; and

WHEREAS, The grant budget does not allow for indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, This grant does not include an Annual Salary Ordinance (ASO) Amendment; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission on April 8, 2008, adopted resolution no. 08-0067 authorizing the General Manager to request permission from the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend EPA grant funds; now, therefore, be it
