Resolution extending by an additional 120 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on a proposed Ordinance that would amend the Planning Code by repealing Section 825.1 and amend Planning Code Sections 135, 309.1, 318.3, 809, 825 and 827 to apply many of the provisions of Rincon Hill Downtown Mixed Use Zoning District to all Downtown Residential Districts and to add design requirements to enhance the pedestrian environment.

WHEREAS, On September 11, 2007, Supervisor Daly introduced legislation to initiate the process to amend the Planning Code by repealing Section 825.1 and amend Planning Code Sections 135, 309.1, 318.3, 809, 825 and 827 to apply many of the provisions of Rincon Hill Downtown Mixed Use Zoning District to all Downtown Residential Districts and to add design requirements to enhance the pedestrian environment. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071292 and is incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, On or about September 24, 2007, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has worked with stakeholders through the Eastern Neighborhoods Planning effort to add design requirements that enhance the

pedestrian environment. A draft of the Eastern Neighborhoods controls was recently published in mid-April 2008. The Planning Department has requested additional time to allow public review of the Eastern Neighborhoods controls to determine if the proposed Ordinance has been effectively incorporated into the draft Eastern Neighborhoods controls; and,

WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning Commission additional time to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That by this resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance for another additional 120 days, to allow for the Planning Department to satisfy the goals of the proposed ordinance through the draft Eastern Neighborhoods rezoning effort.
